<b>Lesson 1</b>	Learn how to help your student <b>Move Beyond Counting</b> strategies.	Lesson 1
<b>Before-AIM Assessment</b>	This now includes <b>setting program goals</b> with your student. If you have already started the program, you can review the last page of this document to talk about what you and your student hope to accomplish.	Lesson 1 (Assessment tab)
<b>Lessons 2 - 9</b>	Read through the instruction and review the examples to see how to apply the <b>Commutative Property of Addition</b> using the Build, Write, Say method to help your student most efficiently master the addition facts.  If you are beyond Lesson 2 and still working through the addition lessons, it is recommended you read the updated Lesson 2 instruction where the <i>Commutative Property of Addition</i> is introduced and modeled.	Lessons 2 - 9
<b>After-Addition Assessment</b>	After completing Lessons 1 - 9, go to Lesson 9 (Assessment tab) to find an assessment of all the addition facts. Use this to compare addition fact mastery achieved since the start of the program, as well as to determine when to move on to the subtraction lessons.	Lesson 9 (Assessment tab)
<b>Lessons 10 - 11</b>	Now called the <b>Bridge to Subtraction lessons</b> . These two lessons contain updated content and images that will help better connect the addition facts previously mastered to learn the strategies to master the subtraction facts.	Lessons 10 -11
<b>Lessons 12 - 22</b>	The subtraction lessons contain updated images of the blocks and clarification of the strategies presented based on customer feedback.	Lessons 12 -22

<b>After-Subtraction Assessment</b>	<p>After completing Lessons 10 - 22, go to Lesson 22 (Assessment tab) to find an assessment of all the subtraction facts. Use this to compare subtraction fact mastery achieved since the start of the program, as well as to determine when to move on to the Mastery Review.</p>	<p>Lesson 22 (Assessment tab)</p>
<b>Mastery Review</b>	<p>After completing the After-Subtraction Assessment, take a few days to review all the facts in the program. You will find suggestions for how to do this in the Mastery Review.</p>	<p>Lesson 22 (Assessment tab)</p>
<b>After-AIM Assessment</b>	<p>When you and your student feel ready, complete the After-AIM Assessment to compare their progress from the start of the program and to evaluate if you both met your goals for the program.</p>	<p>Lesson 22 (Assessment tab)</p>
